

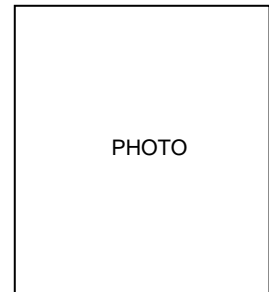

<p>I am aware of and consent to the following: the collection of the data required by this application form and the taking of my photograph and, if applicable, the taking of fingerprints, are mandatory for the examination of the visa application; and any personal data concerning me which appear on the visa application form, as well as my fingerprints and my photograph will be supplied to the relevant authorities of the Member States and processed by those authorities, for the purposes of a decision on my visa application.</p> <p>Such data as well as data concerning the decision taken on my application or a decision whether to annul, revoke or extend a visa issued will be entered into, and stored in the Visa Information System (VIS)¹ for a maximum period of five years, during which it will be accessible to the visa authorities and the authorities competent for carrying out checks on visas at external borders and within the Member States, immigration and asylum authorities in the Member States for the purposes of verifying whether the conditions for the legal entry into, stay and residence on the territory of the Member States are fulfilled, of identifying persons who do not or who no longer fulfil these conditions, of examining an asylum application and of determining responsibility for such examination. Under certain conditions the data will be also available to designated authorities of the Member States and to Europol for the purpose of the prevention, detection and investigation of terrorist offences and of other serious criminal offences. At my express request, the authority examining my application will inform me of the manner in which I may exercise my right to check the personal data concerning me and have them corrected or deleted, including the related remedies according to the national law of the State concerned. The national supervisory authority of that Member State (<i>Commission Nationale de l'Informatique et des Libertés – 8, rue Vivienne – 75083 PARIS cedex 02</i>) will hear claims concerning the protection of personal data.</p> <p>I declare that to the best of my knowledge all particulars supplied by me are correct and complete. I am aware that any false statements will lead to my application being rejected or to the annulment of a visa already granted and may also render me liable to prosecution under the law of the Member State which deals with the application.</p> <p>I undertake to leave the territory of the Member States before the expiry of the visa, if granted. I have been informed that possession of a visa is only one of the prerequisites for entry into the European territory of the Member States. The mere fact that a visa has been granted to me does not mean that I will be entitled to compensation if I fail to comply with the relevant provisions of Article 5(1) of Regulation (EC) No 562/2006 (Schengen Borders Code) and I am therefore refused entry. Basic Check List of Required Documents

(See website and previous emails for full break down details of requirements)

- [] I have enclosed current valid passport(s) with valid UK Leave/ Residence permit/visa (or UK Biometric ID card). Both have validity that **exceeds 3 months** after my return from my proposed trip
- [] I have completed application form in full and signed **both** signature boxes. (**box #37** & the last declaration signature box)
- [] I have enclosed 2 passport photos that were taken within the last 30 days and comply with UK passport standards as shown on website.
- [] I have enclosed my **Employers letter** (+ last 3 months payslips) **OR College letter** of reference (where student)
 - The letter is on formal **Letter Headed Paper**, its date will show it to be **less than one month old** at the time of submission to the embassy and it has been hand signed by an official at my company/college (the college letter has the college's official endorsement/stamp)
- [] I have enclosed a bank statement from a **current/cheque account** with a balance date that will show it to be **less than one month old** at the time of submission to the embassy.
 - The balance shows in GBP/Stirling (or Euros) the equivalent of at least £50 per day of the proposed trip.
 - The bank statement **shows my name** in print and my address (preferred – see website for alternatives)
- [] I have enclosed a printout of the Hotel booking reservation confirmation details from the **actual hotel/hotel chain** in addition to the a 3rd party hotel/hostel bookings provider (travel agent OR online booking agent)
 - * The booking confirmation **shows my name, the reservation dates** and amount/deposit paid.
- [] I have enclosed a printout of the travel / ticket reservation confirmation details (or tickets). The reservations **show my name, the dates of travel** and the amount paid
- [] I have enclosed a printout of my travel insurance cover policy. The printout shows the policy number, my name, the period of cover and the cash amount of cover section of the policy wording. **It is a Travel insurance policy with repatriation**. It is **NOT** just a medical insurance policy. I am aware that a single trip policy **can only result** in a single trip visa whereas an annual cover policy might result in a long term multiple entry visa.
